- (b) Name **three** religious objects which you would expect to find in this building. [3]
- (c) Explain the importance of this building for the Jewish community. [6]

In this section, answer **both** parts of **two** questions.

4 CHRISTIANITY

- (a) Describe what happens in the service of Holy Communion (Eucharist). [12]
- (b) Explain the importance of this service for Christians. [12]

5 ISLAM

- (a) Describe a religious wedding ceremony in Islam. [12]
- (b) Explain the importance of a religious wedding for Muslims. [12]

6 JUDAISM

- (a) Describe what happens in a Jewish home at the festival of Pesach (Passover). [12]
- (b) Explain the importance for Jews of the events celebrated at the festival. [12]

In this section, answer **both** parts of **either** Question 7 **or** Question 8.

- 7 (a) For **two** of Christianity, Islam and Judaism, describe the sacred writings of the religion. [12]
- (b) Explain why these sacred writings are important to believers in **each** of the two religions you have chosen. [12]
- 8 (a) For **two** of Christianity, Islam and Judaism, name a place of pilgrimage and describe what pilgrims do there. [12]
- (b) Explain the importance of pilgrimage to the believers of **each** of the two religions you have chosen. [12]
